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1. Surface preparation

Step 1. Remove fouling, dirt and salts by power wash.



Step 2. Degrease the surface.

Option 1. Grit blast the surface by abrasive blasting to Sa $2\frac{1}{2}$ (ISO 8501-1) & roughness 60 ± 10 μ m.



Option 2. Minimal preparation with power tools to roughen the surface to St 2 or St 3 (ISO 8501-1).



Step 4. Remove dust and clean with fresh water.



Step 5. Clean with cleaning agent.



Step 6. Check the surface preparation.

• Check for salts (Bresle) – ISO 8502-6, ISO 8502-9 (< 60 mg/m²)



• Check the roughness – ISO 8503-2 (optimal surface prep: $60 \pm 10 \mu m$; minimal prep: original profile)



• Check for dust – ISO 8502-3 (Q \leq 3, C \leq 3)



2. Coating application

Step 7. Delivered in pre-dosed pails (A and B).

Check the labelling: - Mixing ratio by weight: 3,7:1

- Mixing ratio by volume: 3,475:1



Step 8. Temperature non-mixed Humidur FP Brush LT: 5 – 15 °C

Step 9. Agitate component A prior to mixing. Empty Component B into A and mix for 3 minutes.

Step 10. Temperature after mixing Humidur FP Brush LT: 5 – 15 °C.

Step 11. Ideal temperature surface: 0 °C – 15 °C. No condensation allowed!



Step 12. Apply the product by brush.



Step 13. Check the wet layer thickness during application.

Consult your Acotec representative for the required thickness (max. WFT 400 µm per coat).

WFT = DFT



Step 14. Allow curing: at 10 °C: 72 hours Capable of curing under water.
